The Hudson Valley enjoys a rich history, and the quaint town of Hyde Park has claimed an especially distinct cultural heritage. The Town of Hyde Park Historical Society works to help preserve the town's past for future generations to enjoy. Historical artifacts and memorabilia have been donated by the townspeople and are displayed to allow a glimpse into what life was like many years ago. Our Museum is located in the former firehouse building at 4389 Albany Post Road in Hyde Park, NY.

The Historical Society offers interesting exhibits at the museum, as well as programs and special events at the Little Red Schoolhouse. Additionally, every other year we have sponsored a Hyde Park History Day contest for local students who live in the Hyde Park Central School District, awarding monetary prizes to the winners.

The Town of Hyde Park Historical Society presents several different events during the year. Their major fund raiser is the annual "Eleanor Roosevelt Knit-In," scheduled for the first Sunday each May at the Henry A. Wallace Visitors and Conference Center, which is located at the F. D. Roosevelt Presidential Library and Museum on Route 9 in Hyde Park.

Monthly meetings are usually held at the Hyde Park United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall on Route 9 at Church Street the last Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. (except June, July, August, & December). Each meeting has an interesting speaker who talks about local history, followed by refreshments and a business meeting. Anyone over 18 and interested in local history is welcomed to join. **Membership dues from January to December are \$15/year for an individual and \$25/year for two adults at the same address.**

The Town of Hyde Park Historical Society Museum is open from June through October on Sundays from 1-4 p.m. and on Saturdays in conjunction with the Hyde Park Farmers Market from 10-2 p.m. Special tours may also be arranged. The Historical Society is located on the north side of the old firehouse at 4389 Albany Post Road, Hyde Park, NY, just north of the Hyde Park town hall.

The Little Red Schoolhouse is open by appointment by calling (845) 229-9029 during warmer weather, and the historical society's website will list special Open House events planned there.
